Activity	Hazard	Controls
Traffic movements	Pedestrians, horse or property struck by vehicle.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Obey all signs. A speed limit of 10kph is recommended. • Vehicles to enter by main gate and stick to hard areas. • If high traffic flow in parking area extra care should be taken. • All road rules apply.
Visitors entering controlled areas	Accidents from horse / pedestrian / vehicle contact.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spectators to stay behind fencing outside of the arena. • Care should be taken when entering wash / tie up area. • Gates to be kept shut at all times. • Comply with traffic controls and signs. • Horse movements outside of the arena to be at trot or slower only. • Children should be supervised by an adult at all times.
Use of other vehicles and 4WD bikes	Vehicle / pedestrian interaction, vehicle/vehicle interaction, property damage.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver must be licensed. • Vehicles must stay on hard areas. • All best practice guidelines are to be followed. • Approved helmets are to be worn at all times while riding bikes. • Only one person on bike unless it is designed for more than one person. • Ensure that all objects being carried are secure.
Earthquake	Earthquake during or prior to activity.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current emergency plan in place. • Evaluation plan displayed.
